Welcome to the British Columbia Emergency Management COP. Our vision is to create resiliency in B.C. through the use of common data, information and tools for emergency management. As part of this vision, our goal is to have one common portal to support situational awareness and decision making.

The B.C. EMCOP is accessible to all provincial agencies and external EMBC partner agencies, including First Nations, Local Governments, Critical Infrastructure owners, Federal Departments and NGOs. The COP was created by EMBC and GeoBC as the lead agencies with contributions from partner agencies.

NEW! The Weather tab has been added after the EM Resources tab, the Weather tab provides an in-depth overview of weather conditions and forecasts.

NOTE! Each dataset in the COP is regularly updated at various intervals. The "Last Portal Check" date at the top right of the page is for regular checks, updating and maintenance of the portal. For more information regarding data updates, please select the "three dots" to the right of the layer in the layer list and select "Show Item Details" or contact [GeoBC](#) with any questions.

NOTE! Orders, Alerts, SOLEs and BCRs are generally updated **as required** after GeoBC receives information from EMBCs Provincial Duty Manager (PDM). The PDMs receive this information from local governments when Order, Alerts, SOLEs and BCRs are issued by each jurisdiction.
