

DRIVING IN POOR CONDITIONS

SLOW DOWN:

Fog, snow or slush can make driving dangerous

INCREASE SPACE:

Leave plenty of distance between vehicles

WINTER TIRES:

Provide superior traction in cold weather compared to all-season tires

CHECK TIRES:

Check tire pressure and tread wear

SNOW + ICE AT 0°C

is more slippery than at -20°C or below

30 - 40% SHORTER

stopping distance possible with winter tires

BRAKING WITH AN AWD OR 4WD

is no different than a 2-wheel drive

DECREASED AIR PRESSURE

occurs when temperatures drop
