At Energy Safety Canada, we expect students to demonstrate integrity, respect, responsibility and professionalism. **Students who do not meet the expectations in the Student Code of Conduct may be immediately removed from the course and forfeit their certification.**

To maintain a professional learning environment, students must:



Maintain Integrity

Cheating, plagiarism, unauthorized use of devices and collusion during exams or assessments are strictly prohibited. Violations will result in the immediate forfeiture of the exam and certification.



Show Respect

Treat instructors and peers with respect. Harassment, violence, bullying and discrimination are not tolerated.



Actively Participate

Engage in discussions, assignments and collaborative activities to contribute to a productive learning environment.



Attend the Entire Course

Students must be present for all course content and complete all exercises to gain the necessary skills and knowledge required for certification.



Be Fit for Duty

Students must be in a physical, mental and emotional state that supports learning. Students under the influence of any substances or conditions that impair comprehension and class participation will not be tolerated.

Instructors have authority to enforce the Student Code of Conduct. Any student who violates these policies will receive a warning or immediate removal from the classroom and may forfeit their certification.
