

# OILWELL PERFORATOR SAFETY TRAINING REGISTRATION INFORMATION

#### INTRODUCTION

The following information and attached application form apply **only** to candidates wishing to take the **Energy Safety Canada Oilwell Perforator Safety Training** course for the purpose of obtaining an interprovincial oilwell blaster permit/certificate. The permit/certificate is valid in Alberta, British Columbia, Yukon, Northwest Territories, and Nunavut. The application form also serves as an oilwell blaster permit/certificate application for each of these jurisdictions.

Please read the following information carefully. Incomplete applications will be returned.

#### PRE-REGISTRATION CRITERIA

Candidates must:

- Be at least 18 years of age (19 to hold a blasters permit in the N.W.T.);
- Be able to communicate effectively in English, both verbally and in writing;
- Have a minimum of six (6) months hands-on experience in <u>preparing and firing</u> oilwell charges on site in the past 36 months under the <u>direct</u> supervision of the holder of an oilwell blasters certificate/permit valid in one of the jurisdictions identified above, or be able to meet equivalent criteria as set out by the Oilwell Perforator Advisory Committee; and
- Be physically capable of performing the duties of an oilwell blaster.

#### REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Complete the two-page Energy Safety Canada Oilwell Perforator Safety Training application form;
- Submit the completed application form to the Energy Safety Canada Program Manager for approval prior to the course date. (Students will receive their manual on the first day of class);
- Upon completion of the Energy Safety Canada Perforator Blaster Safety
  Training examination, Energy Safety Canada will issue an interprovincial oilwell
  blaster permit/certificate to successful candidates. There shall be no
  provision for verbal examinations.
- Students must present a piece of government issued photo identification (driver's license, passport, etc.) at the start of the course. Students who do not present photo identification will not be permitted to write the course examination.



**Note:** You will be required to confirm that you have an Explosives Regulatory Division approval letter (or acceptable equivalent) when registering to take the Oilwell Perforator Safety Training Course and to present this proof to the blasting examiner prior to writing the exam.

#### Acceptable equivalence:

- NEXUS Card: Issued by the Canada Boarder Services Agency.
- FAST Card: Issued by the Canada Boarder Services Agency.
- Permis General: Issued under Quebec's An Act Respecting Explosives.
- Firearms Possession and Acquisition Licence (PAL): Issued under the Firearms Act.
- Approval Letter: Issued by Natural Resources Canada.

To obtain an Explosives Regulatory Division approval letter you will need to complete a security clearance through your local police station and submit the clearance along with Form F08-01, to the Explosive Regulatory Division.
