# HAND SIGNALS FOR DIRECTING VEHICLES

Help direct vehicles where you need them to go, and stay safe in the process

## **TURNS**

Point one arm to indicate the direction to turn.



Bend monitoring arm repeatedly toward head to indicate continued turning.



### **DISTANCE TO STOPPING POINT**

Face palms forward, with hands above head. Bring elbow forward and hands together.





## **PROCEED SLOWLY**

#### FORWARD

Always face palms in direction of desired travel.



#### BACKWARD

Then bend both arms repeatedly toward head and chest, and then extend.



# **CLEAR TO LEAVE AREA**

Point at the driver and gain eye contact.



### Turn and extend arms in desired direction



## **STOP**

Cross both arms above head.



## **EMERGENCY STOP**

Start with hands clasped over head. Extend downward repeatedly until

vehicle stops.
