

HAND SIGNALS FOR DIRECTING VEHICLES

DISTANCE TO STOPPING POINT

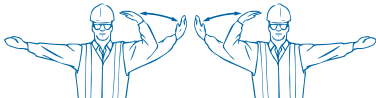
Face palms forward, with hands above head. Bring elbow forward and hands together.



TURNS

Point one arm to indicate the direction to turn.

Bend monitoring arm repeatedly toward head to indicate continued turning.



PROCEED SLOWLY

FORWARD

Always face palms in direction of desired travel.



BACKWARD

Then bend both arms repeatedly toward head and chest, and then extend.



CLEAR TO LEAVE AREA

Point at the driver and gain eye contact.



Turn and extend arms in desired direction.



EMERGENCY STOP

Start with hands clasped over head. Extend downward repeatedly until vehicle stops.



STOP

Cross both arms above head.
